**Date:** Proper date: 14.04.1868

**Description:** Anum and its associated towns are all under arms. A month ago the fighting men moved out to a camp about 5 hours away. They have been joined by the Akem leader Domppe, with his 140 men. You already knew that earlier Domppe had been based on Asutsuare, plundering in that district. Peki has not yet joined this alliance, and so long as this is the case, not much will happen. The Anums feel themselves too weak to attack Akwamu unassisted. The army currently in camp amounts to 600-800 men. So far as one can know what is happening on the Akwamu side, they are ready to make peace. So at the moment they have nothing to fear besides extortion of money.
