written by Indians. Approximately one-third of the documents are written by women. Much of the material is in English. NB the file contains a 13-page offprint of an article by Mark Sanjiva Rao "The Indian Religious Consiousness and the Christian Gospel Message" from the Baptist Missionary Review. The file also includes at 13a copies of a 12-p. pamphlet put out in Udipi: The Jubilee Church Basel Mission Udipi. A report presented to the Churches of the Udipi Station on the occasion of the seventy-fifth year Jubilee....1929, 12 pp. The full missionary reports are numbered 1-36. The indexing is as cursory as in C-4-2.1. The great majority of the reports are typewritten. Some reports also exist in French original/translation. A selection of particular items: A 10 page single-spaced typewritten translation into German of the CVs of 11 students of the Mangalore Theological Seminary (Schosser, Indigenous Report No. 6). - Denkinger assessing the way indigenous evangelists go about preaching (Report No. 7, Mulki). -Conflictual relations with Hindus in the Kodakal area (Renz' annual report for Kodakal, report No. 35). - A very concrete description of travelling with a Bible Woman in the Motebennur area (Louise Saladin, report No. 22). - A
