Description: Comments that it is nearly time for the Christian community to migrate out of Gyadam to the environs of the mission station - that this will be good for them, since they have suffered a fair amount of teasing in the town. Also if they are going to the Christians they will have to be working people. He seems to be getting particularly loyal help from 4 15-17 year olds, who are learning to be sawyers (2), to learning to use a plane, learning to cook and bake (1). They find that training- people is a hard job, but it would be of great importance if boys from Asante, or anywhere else, could come under such training. They are also learning a little reading and writing.
