Description: An account mainly of his journey to Abetifi from Europe. At Cape Coast they went ashore and visited Prince Ansah, and Dr Horton who had treated Mrs Ramseyer so well in 1869. The Ramseyers went to Abetifi accompanied by two girls, one of them Elizabeth, they had taken care of in Kumasi, and since their journey from Kumasi she had been in the girls' boarding school in Aburi (Her day name was Akosua).
