**Description:** Since Catechist Afwireng has been persistently ill, and often apparently close to death, they suggest that he be sent to Dr Fisch in Aburi for a last attempt at cure. Ramseyer in a subscript reports that since his arrival in Aburi Afwireng's brother Deacon Obeng has asked that he be sent to him in Nsakyé. Ramseyer comments that they seem to have more trust in native than European medicine. And in the Stations Conference report itself it is said that Afwireng had been attended by many doctors in Kwahu.
