**Description:** The Nkoranza war continued. This letter is mostly taken up with reporting that the whole matter has gone back to London at Cabinet level, and according to Ramseyer is in the balance with Gladstone opposed to further annexations. Ramseyer feels strongly that the latter is the only course - human sacrifice continues, there is a danger to the surrounding areas. He for his part is taking steps to move into the places where the doors have opened - Agogo and Ahyiaem.
