Description: By no means so opposed as Ramseyer to the idea, and points out that before the troubles in Akim there was a colony of runaway slaves from Kwahu on the station at Kukurantumi. These have since transferred themselves to Abokobi, where there is also a colony of slaves from the coastal areas, Mohr judges that if Abokobi was known as a place where ex-slaves were provided with land etc. they would a great influx. Since the arrival of Mohammedans on the Coast there has been an increase in the numbers of slaves there. He again reports them as Mosis and Grusis.
