Description: An accompanying letter to the report No. 180. He had had a German Government official living-in Bismarckburg with him for 4 weeks - this man had used 'every opportunity' to recommend his missionary work to the people. The priest-king of Siare was famous enough to be asked for advice by the kings of Salaga and Yendi, and is as significant a figure as the Dente priest in Krakye, indeed Dente was a child of Buruku. There are no Mohammedans in the Atwati-Adele area.
