**Description:** Talks about Kibi as his new homeland ('Heimat'). Says in Kukurantumi there are Asante schoolboys. In Kibi they had to suffer a strike when a man slaughtered a sheep and swore they should not work for the mission at least than 2 dollars per thousand bricks. Another law is that no-one should go to Accra for less than 2 dollars.
