Description: Gives the names of the recently baptised: In Kukurantumi Jonas Pabi, Adolph Anokye, Benj. Joshua Tachumase, Emmanuel Owu-adere, David Afum, Daniel Osei. In Kibi Georg Bonte. He reports that among Agyeman's other crimes towards the Asantes was the recent tattooing (with cuts) of the faces of 2 Asantes, also that an under-chief of Agyeman's had been bribed to fight on the side of the Asantes, but that Agyeman had discovered this in time and had been able to dissuade him. The Asantes have strewn branches on the paths they have crossed in Akim as a sign of peace. He found a way from Krobo to Begoro. Begoro he estimates at 3000 'the biggest town in Akim', the people asking for a catechist.
