**Title:** "Schrenk to Basel"

**Description:** On the problem of communicating with Anum, Schrenk feels there is a real danger to the life of a European if he crosses the river at Battor and uses that route to Anum. On the other hand 'Mr Hesse's Joseph' who returned from Krepí with the two carriers who brought Müller's letter (see Anum No 1) says that at the moment that route is open for indigenous travellers, though naturally he does not know for how long, & Schrenk reckons that in the long or short run they must expect it to be blockaded again. He feels that the regular way of contact with Anum must be via Keta, and that the budget should be revised accordingly - though in fact sending material via Keta does not cost too much more.
