Description: Personal News. Their goods arrived only very late at London. They worried about it, but it was good, so they were not spoiled by laying at the bottom. Happy to hear news of the conversion of pagans elsewhere. "Believe me, I am much consoled to know that we have communion with you in Basel in prayer as we have communion with God the father and the son. What a grace! If only I soon could tell it to the poor Africans in their own language! This is my earnest desire, that I may bring some to Christ. They are a poor corrupted people". Copy of this letter typewritten in the personal file of Johann Gottlieb Schmid.
