**Description:** Thanks for a long letter from the inspector. About Frederic Davunnah: He is not doing well-employed for a time in school, but dismissed as unsuitable. Sergeant on the fort, small salary, which does not suffice for his need. Sold a golden watch and locket which the King of Denmark had presented to him, to pay for vice. News about arrival at Akropong: Feels at home among the pagans. Everybody, including the Governor, an Atheist, is kind to him. Time to send more missionaries. Request to get a wife for himself.
