Description: The Governor's hostility continues. He is also behind much of the Akwapim troubles. The matter of Akwapim will be decided in Europe - he guesses it will become British. They expect Governor Maclean back soon. Asked Lutterodt for advise about a journey to Akwamu. Moment not suitable, since Danes and Akwamus negotiate for a new treaty and the Governor would think that they want to interfere. Perhaps they shall travel to Akim. The Akims are proud and haughty.
