Description: The fruit juice (Raspberry syrop) was very handy for the sickness of Stanger and on journeys. The map of the Gold Coast printed in the mission periodical 1827 is wrong for Akwapim (follow exacter distances). Please supply with wine: types and prices of wines on the Coast - food eaten by the Europeans and where they get local food. Meat: danger of hens (wild cats, ants) - sheep from Ada. Mrs. Riis smokes and salts meat to preserve. Details about the disadvantages of cowries. Ccounting takes a long time, heavy for transport got from Christiansborg at a loss, more advantageus to get goods at netto prices.
