Description: Thanks for letter, especially all the document concerning the case Governor contra Riis. The accusation of the Governor against him revealing. He uses Christian language in it, but in his life out here he lives like a pagan and despises the word of God. The Governor reproached Riis, that he knews everything that was happening in Akwapim, but did not tell him about it anymore. Riis had indeed refrained from doing so from the moment onwards when there began a tension between the Akwapims and the Danish Government. Short note about a journey to Shai etc. The roof is being repaired.
