Work at Akropong: Prayers, West Indian school Not printed: Thompson is doing well in Christiansborg (p 4). Requests for schools from Labadi and Teshi - account of visits there (p 4-5). To train Africans in Europe is not advisable now (p 6). Building work at Akropong (p 9). Request for teachers from Sierra Leone. New chaplain a kind man brought greetings from king, who told him to collaborate with the mission (p 12).
