Description: Happy relations to chaplain Jorgensen. He asked Riis to take service and administrate the Lord's supper. During his sickness Riis looked after his congregation and helped him with medical advise from his experience. Rev. Greaves in Accra sick, also Riis' wife (p 2). Riis has bought a plantation in Abokobi where a school could be erected and which could serve as quarter for them when travelling to Akropong. It costed him 47 rigsdalers. Asks, if the mission want to take it over?
