Description: The effect of the Owusu Akyem tragedy. Work at Akropong: They lost sleep and appetite. Africans from the town consoled them "the Lord will change it for the best". Ussu servants all but 8 run away. Difficulty to get carriers. 7 Ussu carriers threatened at Akropong and bought free by Riis for 64 rigsdalers.
