Description: Feels abandoned by God since the newly arrived brethren have told him about the expressions Riis used against him calling Thompson "Pilatus" and stating that he never would eat with an African at the same table. About the school doing well. Lutterodt took his son from fort school and sent him to Thompson, because his slave learned so.
