Description: Andreas Riis will leave for Europe the next day. He is very bitter against the other missionaries, especially against the young brethren. The house he bought in Ussu and repaired with mission funds he wants the missionaries to pay rent for. He has in it also a Dane, Dr.Hansen, who sells brandy in it, even on a Sunday. Riis sold much of his clothes and even mission clothes, which the missionaries would badly need for the West Indians.
