Description: Dutch Accra burned down (p 1). Financial difficulties: No money to be got on the coast (p 1-2). Need to care for the Mulatto girls, even if they are to become concubines later. This is a special reason to have pity on them (p 3). Plan to hand over school and chaplaincy: Left to committee's decision, good relations with the Danish chaplain. About the stationing of brethren at Aburi (p 3-4). Plan to start an English school at Ningo. Labadi: Teacher employed called Meyer, a Methodist salary 14 shillings a month (p 5).
