Description: Financial affairs. The committee is not ready to send out teachers. He saw himself forced to close the school at Labadi-at first temporarily, then definitively. He will have to do the same at Teshi (p 2). He has concluded a contract with Mr. Lutterodt for the erection of a chapel for 500 dollars (p 2). Thompson does not show deep repentance but is obedient. It is a pity that he had to go. He was the best schoolmaster they had. His wife is a model in fidelity and piety (p 3). Explains why he can't yet preach without an interpreter - too busy to learn the language. The teacher Heinze from the Gossner mission has returned after a fortnight only to Tantom, their station (p 5). The Hamburg missionaries still there. Yesterday one went to Krepee to explore possibilities there. About Ningo: He will hurry nothing but the Missionary Society should spare no money to get a connected mission field. This does not mean competing with the Wesleyans (p 5).
