Description: Glad that inspector encourages him to plant. Widmann had been against it but he, Mohr, liked it very much to serve the pagans thus. 2-300 plantains and Banana planted, 5-600 little coffee tree seedlings transplanted, about 1000 Yams, beans. The West Indians encouraged by his success. Especially Rochester plants much Yams, plantains and bananas. Mrs. Rochester makes groundnut oil. Repair of the sawing machine, much trouble. Oranges do well. He needs seedlings for grapes, fir trees and pine trees, tobacco seeds and instruction how to make tobacco. Making a better path. Buildings.
