Description: Personal affairs with the West Indians: Widmann sees that in a certain case he did wrong (pp 1-3). About the planting: It is uneconomic to plant native fruits and root (yams etc.). Better concentrate on coffee and other products not planted by the local people. It would be good if the endless building could be speeded up and then it could be ended and more time given to planting (pp 3-5). About the stonehouse (p 5).
