**Description:** Greens still not yet away, they had difficulties to find warm clothes for them. They do not think it advisable to care for a settlement of liberated slaves, they lack the people for it. Marriages of Christian men and pagan women must be allowed. Financial matters. The school at Christiansborg has been reduced to more manageable proportions. But under the present circumstances even that school cannot be supervised properly. Asks to send people. Dieterle temporarily to go to Ussu.
