**Description:** Extracts from diary: Sir Winniet says that the school will receive from the British government the same amount as the Danes had paid (p 1). Attempts to get the people to listen to sermons: Houseboys sent to town, people demand rum after service. English soldiers, West Indians attend services (pp 2-3) Death of Lutterodt and Governor Winniet. Dec. 13th: To Teshi in order to close down the school. The Christians there very sad, they promise more visits (p 4). Street preaching in Labadi: Attack on Laakpa, the local God (pp 4-6).
