Description: Sickness. Cured with chinin (p 1). About the plantation: Coffee and arrowroot plantation increased. They no longer need to buy plantains or Bananas. Zimmermann brought much seed, will try out lucerne ("Klee") and cattle rearing. A stable shall be built. Then they may get butter and cheese and manure for the coffee plantation. West Indians sick, this holds back work. Hall supervisor on farm. Rochester and Mullings supply wood (p 2). Sickness and marriage (p 3).
