Teacher there kind, showed him a Coran and a new testament in modern Arabic. But he only understands literary Arabic, not modern Arabic. Some Odonko people baptised by the Methodists (pp 12-13). Cows brought into stable of Mr. Lutterodt junior. Hard job, cattle wild. Hope to tame them for milking and drawing of chariots (p 13). Making ropes for the cattle rearing and taming job (p 14). Linguistic work: Collection of words, grammar studied (p 15-16). Rev. Hanson now British consul in Liberia.
