Description: Abraham Tette at Teshi was in temptation to start trading in rum. They therefore settled him at Abokobi where he works on a plantation for a salary and the products belong to the mission. Should they not settle more Christian converts there for a small annual rent in yams? It would help community live. At Ussu: They got land from the government to plant Coconut trees and some cotton.
