Description: About the various households of the missionaries. How the work is distributed. Notes about the religion: Nyankopong-Asase-Bosomprame and his two sons: Kyengku(Obosomase-fetish) and Oda (the most cruel and most feared son of Bosompra). Osiawu: fetish of Larteh (p 2) Family fetishes: same fetish makes marriage between families impossible. People no longer believing in fetish. Baptismal candidates: 5 boys,some girls. Schhool: Alexander Clerk doing well. Number of children cloth given. Textbooks used (pp 3-4). Seminary, characterization of the students (pp 4-6). Girls' education: housegirls (pp 6-7).
