Description: One bound volume consisting of 305 documents and divided into ten sections, including sections for the newly-founded stations Nyasoso and Buea, and a special section concerning disagreements among the Basel missionaries ("Misstände") in Cameroon. The Lobethal section specifically covers Edea; Diverse Akten betreffend Kamerun - miscellaneous letters and reports on the Mission in Cameroon, Documents 1-35; No. 2: von Jacoby (Berlin) informs the Basel Mission that the practice in German colonies of paying workers with liquor will be abolished; No 27 and No 28: after an expedition to Bali by German colonial officials the Basel Mission is asked to send missionaries to the Bali area; General-Präses und Ausschuss für Kamerun: letters and reports from the Mission's Local Chairman and Local Executive Committee, Documents 36-121; No. 36: Report by Bohner on a meeting with Governor Seitz on the liquor question and Cameroon; No. 114: Bohner mentions that Nyasoso, Bombe and Edea should taken into consideration as Sites for new stations for the Basel Mission; Papiere betreffend Misstände im Kreis der Kamerunerbrüder - papers on conflicts between Basel Missionaries in Cameroon, Documents 122-162. Written by different missionaries and addressed to the Inspector in Basel; Bethel: letters and reports from the Station at Bethel (Bonaku), Documents 163-176; Bonaberi- letters and reports from the Station at Bonaberi, Documents 177-217; Nos. 196-198: estimates for the building of a mission Station at Bombe; Mangamba: letters and reports from the Station at Mangamba, Documents 218-225; Nyasoso: letters and reports from the new Station at Nyasoso, Documents 226-240; No. 240: Basedow's Annual Report in which he gives a detailed account of the beginnings in Nyasoso and reports on encounters with the Chiefs, elders and people; Lobethal (Edea): letters and reports from the Station at Lobethal (Edea), Documents 241-268; Nos. 241-243: The Lobethal missionaries complain about the plans of Catholic missionaries to settle near Basel Mission stations; No. 248: Hermann writes about his experience on a journey to the area of Nyaku, Batanga and Nyong; No. 256: Mrs Scholten writes on the need for Girls' Schools in this district; Victoria: letters and reports from the Station at Victoria, Documents 269-289; Buea: letters and reports from the Station at Buea, Documents 290-305; Nos. 292 and 298: Bizer asks for permission and money for the building of a boys' school in Buea; No. 297: Bizer on the question of who is to work in Sopo: the Baptists or the Basel Mission?; No. 303: Sketch map of the Basel Mission's land in Buea
