for use in the Mission's Secondary Schools. See also Nos. 30 and 31-No. 39: Minutes of the Missionaries' General Conference where, inter alia the founding of a girls' school and the Coming of a mission doctor are discussed; No. 60: Printed booklet ("Lehrplan für die Mittel- und Gehilfenschule in Kamerun", 29 pages) with the Basel Mission curriculum for secondary schools. Nos 64-108: documents discussing disagreements among the missionaries in Cameroon, along with a circular letter from the Inspector in Basel addressed to them all; Bethel: letters and reports from the Station at Bethel (Bonaku), Documents 109 - 121; No. 113a: envelope containing drawings of a projected Workshop in Bonaku; No. 114: report by Göhring on a journey to the Elungasi area; Bonaberi: letters and reports from the Station at Bonaberi, Documents 122-144; No. 129: Nusser describes the people with whom he is working (Einige Charakterzüge unserer Leute); Bombe: letters and reports from the Station at Bombe, Documents 145-156; No. 152: Lauffer mentions a Conference between the missionaries and three Chiefs; No. 160: Lauffer on the conversion of people in Mukonva; Mangamba: letters and reports from the Station in Mangamba, Documents 166-179; No. 168: Wittwer reports a case of witchcraft, where, allegedly, 19 innocent people were killed, and the matter was brought before a colonial court; No. 177: sketch map of the Mangamba Station; Nyasoso: letters and reports from the Station at Nyasoso, Documents 180-202; No. 188: building Plans for the Station in Nyasoso. (Another plan can be found unnumbered, but bound between documents 193 and 194); No. 200: Dorsch writes of his experiences with the Nyasoso people; Lobethal: letters and reports from the Station at Lobethal, Documents 203-215; No. 212: In his annual Report Scholten mentions trouble with the Losango-men and the Catholics; No. 213: Annual Report of the Boys' School with (No. 214) a copy of the timetable; Edea: letters and reports from the Station at Edea, Documents 216-238; Nos. 216-237 concern additional buildings at Edea; No. 238: the first Annual Report from Edea. It relates Lutz' first experiences with the people in the region around Edea; Victoria: letters and reports from the Station at Victoria, Documents 239-264; No. 246: Bizer and Gonser on a journey from Cameroon Mountain to Lake Richard; No. 249: Gonser on the baptism of a polygamist and his 8 children; Nos. 254 and 256: the missionaries request permission to open a shop in Victoria. The building Plans are at No. 256a; No. 264: on the Catholic mission in this area; Buea: letters and reports from the Station at Buea, Documents 265-270; No. 268: report by Bizer to the "Akademischer Missionsverein Tübingen" (a Student group in Tübingen interested in Mission) on his work and the Mission's Boys' Boarding School in Buea; No. 270: Annual Report mentioning the expropriation of land and its consequences for the people
