Description: 137 documents divided into 6 sections. Letters and reports from Cameroon in 1907 were bound into three volumes: all Quarterly and Annual Reports are bound into the third volume. All other letters and reports are bound into volumes one and two; Diverse Akten betreffend Kamerunmission - one document only under this heading: miscellaneous documents concerning the mission in Cameroon; No. 1: Berner, the Protestant missions' representative at the Colonial Office in Berlin informs the Basel Mission that Dr. Häberlin has Government permission to practise medicine in Cameroon; Ausschuss für Kamerun: letters and reports from the Mission's Local executive Committee and its members, Documents 2-91; No. 7: Stolz as Local Chairman mentions atrocities by German colonial troops in Bali. See also No. 50. He also mentions a journey to Togo to see a colonial exhibition of all useful plants which are found in Togo. See also Nos. 9 and 10; No. 11: Stolz mentions the expropriation of land around Bonaberi for the planned railway, see also Nos. 35, 70-73, 81 and E-2.25 No. 20; No. 66: Stolz asks for another doctor to be stationed in Bali and mentions the great success Dr Haeberlin has had in Duala; Nos 76 and 77: Jacob Modi's two essays, "On the blessing of God" and "The life of the teacher Isaak Njo", both written in the Duala language and translated into German by Stolz; No. 78: Stolz comments on mission work in the Buea mountain area; No. 79-80: Dinkelacker on a strike in the Buea Middle School; No. 82: Stolz reports on a Conference with the Governor on the sale of liquor, the dowry System and the use of indigenous languages in primary schools; No. 83: Stolz "A few points on indigenous marriage customs"; No. 87-91: Dinkelacker and Köngeter's Annual Reports on schools with information on the curriculum for Middle Schools; Bonaku: letters and reports from the Station at Bonaku, Documents 92-121; Nos. 110-111: Stolz stresses the need to build a hospital in Bonaku; a drawing of the proposed buildings; No. 112: Dr Haeberlin explains the reasons for building a hospital for Cameroonians, see also Nos. 115, 117 and 118; Bonaberi: letters and reports from the Station at Bonaberi, Documents 122-124; Bombe: letters and reports from the Station at Bombe, Documents 125-127; Mangamba: letters and reports from the Station at Mangamba, Documents 128-137; Nos. 132-133 and 135: a new middle school is to be founded in connection with a new Station in Yabassi; No. 134: a sketch-map of the Yabassi area
