Soans' reports on the baptism of an adolescent, on preaching at Hindu festivals, and Hindu objections to Christianity (Kundapur 97, 98 & 101) First baptisms in Basarur (Kundapur 100) Brahmin conversions in Kerki and other places (Honowar 103) German translations of S. Bunyan's reports on preaching journeys in the Honowar district (Honowar 114, 118 & 121) Missionaries report on preaching journeys in the Honowar district (Honowar 115, 116, 122) Deacon Kamsika reports on the Honowar congregation (Honowar 119) Mrs Gengnagel has a three and a half-page report on the girls' school in Honowar and her house-to-house visits (Honowar 124) A conflict between Kaundinya and Eble generate the documents Anandapoor 131-144. Hindu festival in Kurchi (Anandapoor 145); Travelling in southern Kurg (Anadapoor 147); "The farmer or tenant of Ammattinad" (Kaundinya) (Ananadapoor 148) Kaundinya on the Talekwari & Kodagas, the Kembatti Holeyas, the Balagai Holeyas in Mysore and the Basavi (Anandapoor 149).
