Purchase of land for a cemetery in Kodakal, in Chittata and Tschalascheri (Kodakal 214, 216 & 224). Opposing religious prejudices against inoculation (Kodakal 226) A new kind of work for women - spinning coconut fibres (Kodakal 228). Repairing the well in Angadipuram (Waniyankulam 236) Rounding off mission land in Waniyankulam by purchase (Waniyankulam 234-236) Experienced missionary on Hinduism and Islam (Waniyankulam 244) Sale of 8 small compounds in Wadackencheri (Palghat 247-8) On one of the first girls' boarding school pupils in Northern Kerala (Palghat 253). The Nayer family in North Kerala, inheritance, marriage, ceremonies, festivals, religion (Palghat 254 & 256) There was a Nilgiri Conference in March (Keti 264-269) (partly on the question of starting a third mission station in the Nilgiris, and on building rest houses for preaching journeys) Revised syllabus for the Catechists' School (Keti 271). The request of one David Nercambey to be readmitted to the Christian fellowship (Keti 275-7) General on travelling evangelism in the Nilgiris (Keti 287, 288, 294). Keti 297 is an annual report on travelling evangelism in the Keti and Wynaad districts. General report on the Badaga people (Keti 292). Mission work among the blind (Keti 293). Reports by Pastor Karnaka in English are at Kotageri 307 & 311.
