General reports on travelling evangelism (Mangalore 113 & 121; Mulki 140, 143 & 147; Basrur 208 & 210; Kasergod 227; Puttur 239) Reports by local pastors on their work, some in English original, some only German translation, at (Mangalore 115-7, 129-131; Basrur 208 & 213; Kasergod 223; Puttur 240); Three reports by ladies: Emilie Kaundinya on the School for Brahmin Girls, Miss Krauss on the Balmatta girls' school, and a seminary for women teachers, and Mrs Hermelink on the Bible Women (Mangalore 126-128). Visits to Hindu temples and their festivals (Mulki 138 & 139) Should the tile-works in Malapu be given up? (Udipi 166) A teacher petitions for a loan (Udipi 167-8). Building a girls' school "in" the Bazaar in Karkal (Karkala 194-200, 203) 1900 is evidently a drought year (Udipi 178; Karkala 202; Basrur 206; Anandapur 251 & 253) The school in Hosadurga (Kasergod 121) Printed 16 p. report on BGM schools in Udipi. (printed at the Hindu Press) not bound and not indexed, but laid at the beginning of the Udipi section.
