Pastor John Padiath dies of cholera (Calicut 150-151, 163) Wilhelm Haas a European tailor working in the Mission Industry, applies to join the Basel Mission and be recognised as a member of the Mission fellowship (Calicut 152-155) On leprosy work in Calicut (Calicut 146, 159) Annual Report of the Tile Works in Puttiarakal (Calicut 172). Mission industry in Codacal (Codacal 175-178, 181, 200, 209, 215) including transfer of rice-fields belonging to the Tile Works, and the beginning of a farming project. An "Industry Conference" was held in Codacal in June (Codacal 183-190). It is headed "Wage Problems". Unemployed members of the congregation in Codacal to be moved to Palghat (Codacal 196-9; Palghat 230-231). There is an Annual Report (Codacal 212-3) covering the Boarding School for Orphans and the Agricultural School The Lower Secondary School in Ottapalam applies for funds for a library, gymnastic equipment and a latrine (Waniyankulam 217) Life History of the Evangelist Ashamayan Tumarán (Wayankulam 219): Plague, famine and earthquake (Palghat 233).
