Description: Missionary colleges in a heathen country 82 pp., MS format between A-5 and A-4, with detailed list of contents at end. A typewritten note gives the date of origin: 1907 or 1908. The document was written in connection with a Basel Mission discussion, both in the Committee and among the missionaries in India, about the need for further or secondary education under Mission auspices. A serious-looking survey of the question in India - "classical mission school country" - with several statistical tables at the rear. There are 17 pp. on the views of non-protestant opponents of missionary colleges. The author may have been Wilhelm Johannes Müller, a Basel missionary in India before the First World War.
