Description: 25 gebundene Bände, nicht alle vom gleichen Format (Q-3,1 1820-23 der einzige kleine Band), mit von hand geschriebenen Nachschriften von Briefen allgemeiner Natur, an andere Vereine wie an Mitarbeiter der BM. Documents concerning the Gold Coast: p 20: List of the clothes left by Salbach, Holzwarth and Schmid. P 24: Accounts of Henke, Salbach, Holzwarth and Schmid 1 July 1829-1 March 1830 (Interesting for prices of the period and salaries) p 61-62: Letter to Riis at Akropong, 5 May 1836. Surprise at the happy news from Akropong. The count of Holstein had written that the Danish missionary society would be willing to take over the responsibility for the work of Riis. This would have advantages, but the Mission doesn't want to do anything without him. The happy news made the Mission ready to send missionaries - Johannes Mürdter and Andreas Stanger. The Mission also agrees to Riis' marriage plans and has selected Miss Wolters from Christiansfeld. p 80-83: To Riis in Akropong from Basel, 19 July 1836. Sad, that difficulties in the way of Riis - have written accordingly to Denmark, Count Hollstein unfortunately is dead. About Miss Wolter's passage and the financing of the work. Hope, that 6-8 pious families of craftsmen could be found in Württemberg to come to the healthy Akwapim mountains and to found a beginning of a Christian colony there
