Description: Lithography "According to the nature of A.E. Lebart" (1866), Berg en Dal in Suriname, Lithographic studio of Leopold Kraatz in Berlin. It was created after the presentation of a watercolor made in 1866 by August Ernst Lebart. Lebart was a time working as a missionary of the Moravian Church on Berg en Dal. Lithografie „Nach der Natur von A.E. Lebart“ (1866), Berg en Dal in Suriname, Lithographische Anstalt von Leopold Kraatz in Berlin. Sie entstand nach der Vorlage eines im Jahre 1866 durch August Ernst Lebart angefertigten Aquarells. Lebart war eine Zeit als Missionar der Herrnhuter Brüdergemeine auf Berg en Dal tätig.
